



THE PEACOCK AT ROWSLEY

The Hotel and our facilities

Few Country House Hotels match up to the pedigree of The Peacock at Rowsley. It dates from 1652 and was originally built as a Manor House by John Stevenson. For a short period it was the Dower house to nearby Haddon Hall, the seat of the Duke of Rutland and home of The Manners family. The hotel left the Manners family in 1957 and has recently been purchased, bringing it back into the Haddon Estate, by Lord Edward Manners who has refurbished the entire ground floor and all of the 16 bedrooms. It is furnished with antiques and set in beautiful gardens leading down to the banks of the River Derwent, where you might enjoy a spot of trout fishing. The Peacock also sells the fishing tickets for the 12 rods on The River Wye.

The Bedrooms

Our 16 bedrooms are all en suite (some with a shower only), all have flat screen LCD TV's, DVD players, hairdryer, direct dial telephone, hospitality tray, and a trouser press and ironing board on request. Our large double rooms are furnished with antiques and all have been recently been sympathetically refurbished .

Dining Room

The main dining room, non smoking, serves delicious food in pleasant surroundings overlooking the garden as do the other two dining rooms, both of which can be smoking or non smoking, and can booked for private dining from 4 to 20 persons.

The Bar

The Peacock Bar is a great place to relax and unwind with a log fire during autumn and winter. The bar menu offers a good selection of light snacks to a three course lunch, or dinner for those who prefer a more informal atmosphere.

The Conference Rooms

The two delightful conference rooms offer stunning views over the garden which leads down to the River Derwent.

- The Derwent Room

This is the smaller of the two conference rooms, 17ft x 16ft and can accommodate up to 12 delegates for a board meeting. The room has windows on two sides and can be blacked out for projecting. It also has 8 electrical sockets.

- The Wye Room

Our largest conference room, 25ft x 15ft, which can accommodate 16 delegates for a board meeting. Windows are on the longest wall and can be blacked out for projection. It also has 12 electrical sockets.
